

Session-Log

Choose **Logging - Session Log** in the main menu, to see a protocol of the sessions, i.e. the time in which the user was logged into the web interface.

Reseller UID	The associated reseller account.
Client UID	The associated client account.
User UID	The associated user account.
Begin	The date and time on which the session began.
End	The date and time on which the session ended.
Timeout	Here "yes" is shown, if the session ended due to a timeout. If nothing is shown, the user logged off.
Session ID	This shows the technical session ID at the web server. This information is useful for technical support purposes.
IP Address	The IP address of the machine, from which the user logged in.

In the column **Action** you can click on **Sub-Sessions** to see details on the sub-sessions initiated by this user. These contain details on impersonated users, i.e. accounts the user logged into.
