


Ktn. + Osttirol 04	if the caller calls from an 04 area code from Carinthia or East Tyrol
Vbg. + Tirol 05	if the caller calls from a 05 area code from Vorarlberg or Tyrol
Salzburg 06	if the caller calls from an 06 area code from Salzburg.
OÖ + NÖ 07	if the caller has n 07 area code from Upper Austria or Lower Austria.
